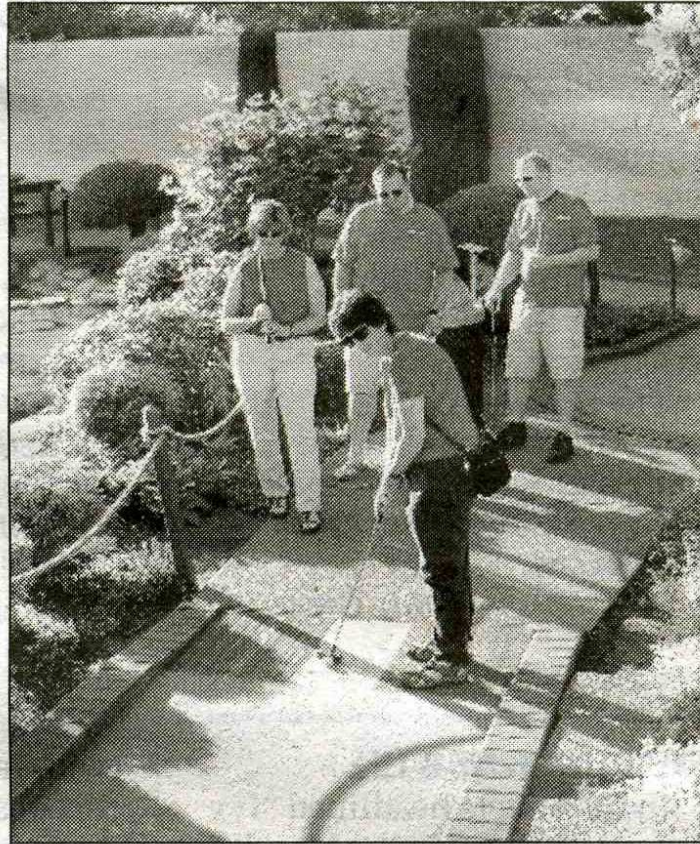


## LET THE GAMES BEGIN

Other events include a 3-point basketball shooting contest, indoor soccer, a 5k run, dodgeball, kickball and racquetball, softball, miniature golf and a trivia challenge.
